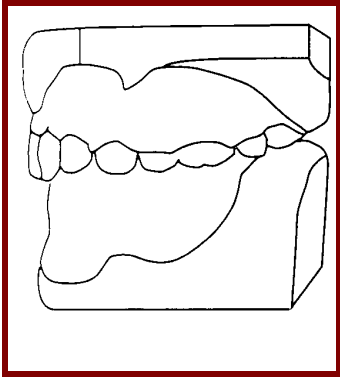


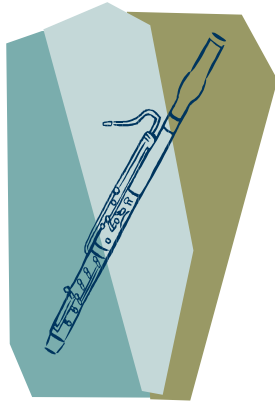
Musical Wind Instruments and Occlusion

This chart is offered as a guideline to help you and your patients consider a musical instrument that is best suited to their occlusion. I hope you find it useful.

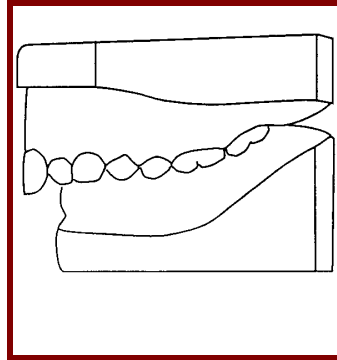
Class 1 Malocclusion

- Saxophone

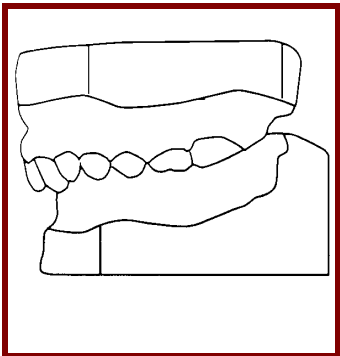


Class II, Division 1 Malocclusion

Short Upper Lip

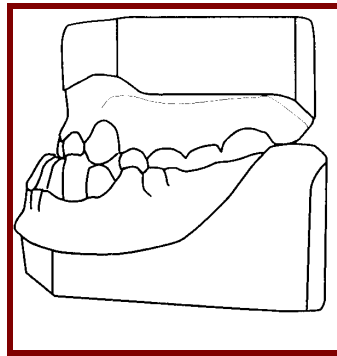
